



Spreading the 'five star hippy' experience from the beaches to the ski fields - and recreating what luxury means in the process Karma Group is an award-winning international travel and lifestyle brand offering extraordinary experiences in the world's most beautiful locations. The company is headed by Chairman and Founder, John Spence, a former Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year Australia and member of the judging panel for the Ernst & Young World Entrepreneur of the Year. Among his numerous other accolades, John was honoured with the Edward P. Bass Honorary Fellowship at YALE University in 2013 & 2019 in the School of Architecture, marking the first time YALE has extended this to the same person more than once.

Karma Group comprises Karma Estates, Karma Resorts, Karma Retreats, Karma Royal, Karma Beach, Karma Spa, Karma Club and Karma Boutique. The Group has developed multiple resorts and currently owns and operates 45 resorts in 12 countries, including Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, India, Indonesia, Spain, Thailand, UK, and Vietnam. Four of these resorts were acquired in the past twelve months with Karma Group demonstrating an ability to acclimatise quickly and successfully to a drastically shifting landscape, with the company choosing to focus on domestic travel markets. These new additions to the company's ever-growing portfolio include Karma Karnak - a Nile cruise experience taking in the highlights of Ancient Egypt, Karma Munnar, a romantic escape in the highlands of Kerala, India - often described as "God's own country"; Karma Salford Hall an historic Tudor property formerly owned by King Henry VIII in England's rural Cotswolds and Karma Lake of Menteith, set on the stunning shores of Scotland's only lake. Karma Group is also developing further acquisitions in Australia, India, Philippines, Sri Lanka, and Japan.



"Whatever you give to the universe comes back," says John. "That's where the whole 'karma' thing comes from. I believe it's everyone's duty to do what they can to help the world and this is at the heart of all of our global enterprises." In 2021 a series of new offerings were introduced, including a private member's club with a difference, Karma Club, and the establishment of a brand new bespoke service for existing Karma Group members in Karma Concierge.

Karma Group is additionally involved in the world of fine wines and spirits. Since 2016, John Spence has been collaborating with leading winemakers across the world to produce bottles that have formed the Karma Wines offering, from Tuscany to Bordeaux to Crete, including a recently released Rosé from France's Carcassonne, home to Karma Chateau de Samary. A signature handcrafted small batch gin was also recently added to the Karma cellar, a spirit crafted from botanicals sourced from the destinations where the group's resorts, hotels, and retreats are located. And our most recent addition to the Karma spirits repertoire is Coachbuilt Whisky, developed by Formula One legend Jensen Button. Karma Group is the official resort partner for this premium blended Scotch single malt whisky which is being rolled out initially across our resorts in the UK and Europe.

Outside the hospitality realm, Karma Group remains a company devoted to supporting its surrounding community. Karma Group continues to run and support a number of philanthropic initiatives worldwide under the Karma Cares banner. Karma Refuge provides shelter and support for those fleeing the conflict in Ukraine, including accommodation at Karma Residence Normande in France. In 2021. Karma Group also spearheaded vaccination efforts in Bali, not only for staff but for their families and surrounding communities. Karma Group also worked with HRH the Prince of Wales Trust and the British Asian Trust to alleviate the Covid19 crisis in India, providing much need oxygen equipment to those most in need, as well as supporting Operation Recuperation, a UK initiative focusing on supporting front-line healthcare providers recover from the fight against Covid-19. Ongoing projects include the sponsorship and support of Bangalore non-profit Christel House India, the Bali Life Foundation for disadvantaged children. and Vietnam's Children's Hope In Action (CHIA). alongside involvement in ongoing scholarships and fundraisers annually.



















KARMA RESORTS

Created in 2002 to offer a high-end luxury villa resort experience in Asia, with five Karma Resorts located in Australia, Germany, Italy and Indonesia (2). Karma Group operates the following products: Karma Resorts: Five-star luxury with a laid back vibe. The Bali boutique villa resorts offer private pools, designer décor, gourmet dining and bespoke activities, from wine tasting to water sports.

Karma Group started the Karma Resort concept following the identification of a gap in the high-end leisure resort market to provide a product that offered luxury lifestyle accommodation of scale, for all the family, with a seamless service experience from arrival, right through to departure. In doing so, the Company is also able to enhance the attractiveness of the entire vacation ownership product range. The properties are operated as hotels using inventory from villa sales and fractionals.

Karma Villas : These are top-end 2-5 bedroom villas, each with a private swimming pool. These properties sell as titlebased real estate, typically, between \$500K and \$5m, and are marketed to HNWI's (High Net Worth Individuals). The Company leases (or receives in a pool) the properties and utilises them as hotel inventory. Profits are shared with owners either through rental pool agreements or guaranteed return arrangements. Substantial expansion potential as disposable incomes in Asia and aspiration for luxury leisure increase.








Karma Estates is Karma Group's elite collection of properties in the world's most exclusive destinations. These beacons of style and sophistication are tailored to a new generation of luxury.





Melding the best in luxury with a selection of hedonistic pleasures, Karma Sanctum promises guests access to an exclusive world of parties, concerts and private gatherings.











During the devastating bushfires in Australia, Karma Group's sales teams donated US\$10,000 raised via a competition set up by John Spence to a frontline team of firefighters - the Mongarlowe Volunteer Bushfire Brigade. Karma Group was quick to respond too when India was hit with the CoVid-19 Crisis. The Karma Mayday Initiative raised more than £50,000 in a very brief period of time in order to deliver much needed respirators and other equipment to hospitals and medical centres, working in partnership with the British Asian Trust and Operation Recuperation, earning a 'Points of Light award' from the UK government in recognition of this contribution.

Most recently, the Group established Karma Refuge, which is providing much needed shelter and support to refugees from Ukraine, opening up Karma Group properties for those most in need, beginning with Karma Résidence Normande on the banks of the River Seine in Normandy, France - one of the first boutique luxury hospitality brands to establish an initiative of this kind.




KARMA ROYAL BENAULIM goa, india, 1996







KARMA ROYAL CANDIDASA bali, indonesia, 1997

Lovers of food may want to book a session at Candidasa's very own Indonesian cooking school and learn the secrets of Balinese cuisine.







KARMA ROYAL MONTERIO goa, indi, 1998

If all you want to do is relax, then MonteRio's luxurious rooms, a great spa and signature restaurant means you'll never have - or want - to leave.






KARMA ROYAL PALMS GOA, INDIA, 1999







KARMA ROYAL JIMBARAN bali, indonesia, 1999

During the evening, stroll along Jimbaran Beach and take in quite possibly the best sunset view in all of Bali.







KARMA ROYAL HAATHI MAHAL goa, india, 2000







KARMA HAVELI JAIPUR, INDIA, 2011
