Soft, dry and approachable Riesling from the multi-award-winning Larry Cherubino estate. The fruit is harvested purely at night to retain freshness. The wine is a melody of bright fruit and floral hues with a mineral finish.

2020, Chateau Mercian Koshu Sur Lie, Koshu From Yamanashi, Japan £28.00

A very elegant, light and dry white wine from the Yamanashi Prefecture in Japan. Grown on volcanic soils, this white is full of fresh layers of pink grapefruit, lemon peel and flint.

2020, Oliver Zeter Grauburgunder, Pinot Gris From Pfalz, Germany £50.00

Pure and expressive German white wine from the charming 'big bear of the Pfalz' winemaker Oliver Zeter. Partially fermented in French oak and left on its lees for a few months, this wine is rich and complex with ripe red apple, hazelnut cream and ripe pear flavours.

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- 29. Gevrey Chambertin Domaine Roux, Burgundy, France** £85.00
Domaine Roux Pere et Fils winemaking heritage stretches back to 1855 and they now own over 70 hectares of vineyards across the region. This Gevrey Chambertin is fine and stylish with well-judged oak and a defined, long finish.
- 30. Morey-Saint-Denis Premier Cru 'Chaffots' 2011** £89.00
First mentioned as far back as 1120, fourteenth century Morey was a place of asylum for Cistercian monks who appeared to have possessed numerous vineyards and even a winery by 1306. The appellation extends from Chambolle-Musigny to Gevrey-Chambertin and covers around 148 hectares 80% of which are planted with grapes for red wines. Les Chaffots indicates places where hay barns used to stand. Elsewhere, the name is "Echaffaud" (scaffold), forks etc. So it is probably the place where those sentenced to death were executed.
- 31. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Beaucastel** £105.00
It is a solar wine worth waiting for. "One of the more endowed 2009s, this is packed with dark smoldering cocoa, mesquite, tobacco and roasted fig notes, all inlaid with pure cassis and plum preserves fruit flavors. Long and authoritative on the finish, with singed vanilla bean and tar adding length and dimension.
- 32. Gevrey-Chambertin, Les Cazetiers, Premier Cru, Burgundy, France 2009** £139.00
Grevey chambertin is a wine with a beautiful , bright ruby colour Intensely fruity on the nose, the aromas are remi nascent of black cherry, Wild Blackberry and liquorice. The woody character is subtle and marries delicately with the other aromas.
- 2019, Larry Cherubino 'Ad Hoc' Middle of Everywhere Shiraz, Shiraz From Great Southern, Australia** £52.00
Larry Cherubino's chunky, full-bodied red wine mixes aromas of ground black pepper with deep, dark berries and an earthy structure. The finish balances blueberry and black cherry notes over warming spice.
- 2019, Sula Vineyards Dindori Reserve Shiraz, Shiraz & Cabernet Sauvignon From Maharashtra, India** £42.00
Something truly different. This is the topflight red from entrepreneur Rajeev Samant and former Sonoma County winemaker Kerry Damskey, who came together to make wine to go with Indian cuisine. Deep and smoky, the red is bursting with jammy blackberries, spice, vanilla and peat.
- 2019, Monsoon Valley Pokdum/Shiraz Red, Pokdum & Shiraz From Hua Hin Hills, Thailand** £32.00
Grown on the floating vineyards of Samut Sakorn and in the Hua Hin Hills, Pokdum is predominantly soft and fruity with lots of freshly picked red plum character. This red is an instant winner.

SHERRY

33. La Guita, Manzanilla (Half Bottle), Spain

£15.00

The name 'La Guita' comes from the old Andalucian slang guita meaning cash (due to its founder being renowned for wanting to be paid in cash). Made in Sanlúcar de Barrameda, La Guita is dry and tangy with subtle nutty flavours.

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
